



2024 YEAR 3 SRS & BOOKLIST

This letter contains important information about the **2024 Student Resource Scheme (SRS) and booklist** including how the scheme operates and the annual participation fee. This fee covers both SRS and booklist resources.

The Queensland Government supports students' education by providing funding for:

- Instruction, e.g. teachers
- Facilities, e.g. buildings, amenities, furniture
- Administration, e.g. staffing and resources to administer the operations of the school.

Funding does not extend to individual student resources such as textbooks, computer or musical equipment for personal use, and many items used/consumed by the student in the classroom. Supply of these items is the responsibility of parents.

To provide parents with a cost-effective alternative to purchasing textbooks and/or resources elsewhere, Amberley District State School operates a Student Resource Scheme for 2024.

The scheme ensures that students have the resources required for them to engage with the curriculum for their education, and saves parents time and money in sourcing the prescribed materials elsewhere. Savings are gained through the school's bulk purchasing practices and hiring arrangements. The scheme is not used to raise funds for other purposes, and revenue collected through the scheme is applied only to the resources and operation of the scheme.

The scheme's operation, resource inclusions and participation fees were approved by the school's P&C Association.

SRS Participation

The objective of the scheme is to provide a convenient and cost-effective way for students to access the educational resources necessary to enhance their learning experience at school. The Department encourages parents to participate in the scheme. Participation in the SRS is optional, and no obligation is placed on a parent to participate.

Participation is for the duration of your child's enrolment at the school.

Student is new to the school.....

Parents are required to complete and return the SRS Participation Agreement Form when joining the scheme for the first time. If no participation form is received by 22nd January, 2024 the school will take the view that the parent has chosen to opt out of the SRS. The parent is then required to provide the educational resources listed in the SRS and booklist for their child by the start of the school year. A parent can opt in or out of the scheme in subsequent years by emailing admin@amberleydistrictss.eq.edu.au.

Continuing student of the school.....

A parent's participation or non-participation in the scheme will continue as per their previously completed Participation Agreement Form. A parent can opt in or out of the scheme in subsequent years by completing another Participation Agreement Form.

If a parent has opted out of the scheme the parent is required to provide the educational resources listed in the SRS and booklist for their child by the start of the school year.

SRS and Booklist Inclusions

All resources included in the SRS and booklist are detailed below. These lists are also available on the school website.

This is a comprehensive list of all resources included in the scheme and their associated costs. The SRS fee is calculated based on a flat fee for a cohort group of students (eg. A year level).

Upon completion of an SRS participation agreement form, students will be provided with items from both SRS and booklist, if these resources are damaged or lost, parents are responsible for replacing these items.
