WHAT does this mean?

The eBooks Digital Library, which is provided on the OverDrive eBooks platform, contains over 10,500 eBooks, audiobooks and videos, including fiction and non-fiction reading material for students, which you can borrow and read 24/7 at home, at school, on your PC, laptop or mobile device.

HOW?

This is what you do.....

- Go to this web address: http://educationqld.lib.overdrive.com
 and login using your MIS ID e.g. tlag4 (you don't need a password).
 YOUR class teacher will give you your ID if you don't already know what it is.
- 2. Browse for a book you like and SAMPLE it first.
- 3. If you really want to read it, then BORROW it.

You may need to install software or apps on your personal computers or devices.

- 1. Download free Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) software, Adobe Digital editions opens EPUB books, which may be read offline and/or on multiple devices.
 - Open the eBooks Digital Library http://educationqld.lib.overdrive.com Login with your MIS ID.
 - Browse or search for titles
 Enter keywords, or browse subjects or collections


